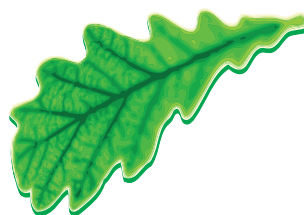

A timber cabin, built with logs from Finland, with beds for 12 people, accessible, toilet and shower facilities, a communal kitchen and dining/recreation/meeting area built in a small camping ground set in remote rural countryside just a quarter of a mile inland from the North Norfolk coast, close to the villages of Mundesley and Overstrand.

What could I use Trimingham Log Cabin for?

- Residential short term “camping barn” style accommodation to local and visiting youth groups, community organisations, and groups of people with disabilities as the venue is fully accessible.
- A camping area for youth groups completing activities such as Duke of Edinburgh’s Awards, Queen’s Scout/Guide Award expeditions, or groups taking part in the Norfolk Coastal long distance path walk.
- A residential centre for identified, and sponsored disadvantaged families to use as a self catering respite short break at an affordable price (bursaries may be available).
- A resource centre to host a series of tailor-made workshops for local individuals and/or community organisations to develop skills in things like fundraising, volunteer recruitment, governance, or team-building.
- A community meeting space for small local community groups (up to 10 people)
- Potential uses may also include a remote centre for social care professionals to provide short term respite care to young people in care, or a safe haven for victims of crime with Police family liaison officers.





The building currently includes a central kitchen and communal area flanked by two bunk rooms with accommodation for 6 people in each unit, with fully (DDA compliant) accessible toilet and shower facilities attached to each bunk room.

A larger camping area and activity space (Approx 0.5 acres) is available for camping across the road from the cabin and is available for a limited number of days each year on request.

The site will normally be available for exclusive use only, so hirers will have use of the whole building and camping area. The kitchen is equipped with plates, bowls, mugs and cutlery for 16 people. There is a large fridge-freezer, domestic style electric cooker, microwave, dishwasher, electric kettle, kitchen utensils and cooking equipment. A full inventory is available on request.



Hirers will be required to bring their own sleeping bags, pillows, and towels.
